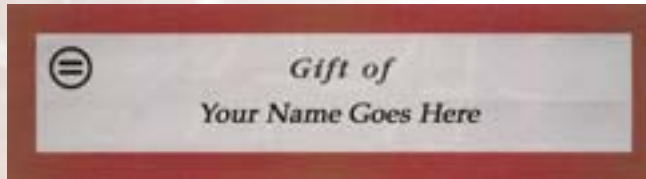

About the League's Headquarters Building

In October 2004, the League moved into its new headquarters and programs building at 2901 14th Street, NW, the landmark former Hines Building, which had been vacant for more than two decades. The 29,000 square foot state of the art building serves as the gateway to the economic development activities taking place in the bustling Columbia Heights section of the city.

About the League

The League, founded in 1938 and one of more than 100 affiliates of the National Urban League, is a major interracial nonprofit 501(c)(3) social services and civil rights organization that serves the District of Columbia, and Prince George's and Montgomery Counties. The League is a member agency of the United Way of the National Capital Area, and our mission is "to increase the economic and political empowerment of African Americans and other minorities and to help all Americans share equally in the responsibilities and rewards of full citizenship." Key program areas are education, employment and training; aging and health services; and housing and community development. **The League serves more than 65,000 persons each year.**
