
Perinatal mental health is gaining more attention as a critical issue within maternal health with severe racial and health equity concerns.


- Almost 50% of Black mothers will experience maternal mental health (MMH) conditions, according to the Maternal Mental Health Leadership Alliance.
- Compared to white women, Black women are twice as likely to experience MMH conditions but half as likely to receive care.
- And . . . Black Dads experience post partum dipression at similar rates as Black Mothers!








